

# Australian Federation of Lies



The Australian Federation of Islamic Societies was established 1964 by 170 Muslim bodies as **AFIS**, then changed to **AFIC**[Councils] in 1976. They wish to:

- Live by the Qur'an under Sharia law<sup>1</sup>, and have a National Sharia Board with 34 Imams<sup>2</sup>;
- Spread Islam in Australia<sup>3</sup>;
- Strengthen the global Islamic network<sup>4</sup>.

They discriminate against 'heretic' Muslims: "Ahmedis, Lahoris, Qadianis ... Bahais are not Muslims."<sup>5</sup>.

Under "**What Is Islam?**"<sup>6</sup> they discuss a number of topics:

## Meaning of "Islam"

*Sometimes Islam is referred to as Mohammedanism. This is a misnomer because it suggests that Muslims worship Muhammad.*

Muslims *do* worship Muhammad, for they must obey him *as if* they obeyed Allah himself. There is no difference:

- Al-Imran 3.31<sup>7</sup>: "If you **love Allah, Follow me** [Muhammad]..."
- Al-Anfal 8.20: "O ye who believe! **Obey Allah and**

**His Messenger, and do not turn away from him [Muhammad?] when ye hear (him speak)'**

- Sura Al-Nisa 4.59: “O ye who believe! **Obey Allah, and obey the Messenger**”.

### **Muslims and their beliefs**

*Muslims believe in all the Prophets ... Adam ... Jesus*

The **Muslim Adam** is false: created **60 cubits tall** *in heaven*, then sent to earth and somehow shrunk in the process, landing in Sri Lanka (Sarandib)<sup>8</sup>!

The **Muslim Jesus** is false: **not crucified** (Q4.157); **not resurrected** (Q4.157); **not the Son of God** (Q6.101). Allah *deceived* hundreds of eyewitnesses who saw the crucifixion and resurrection, then dallied 600 years to reveal the ‘lies’ to an Arab 1,500km away, who never witnessed anything!

*The Holy Qur’an ... lays down ... codes for their social and moral behaviour, and contains a comprehensive religious philosophy*

The Qur’an is *not* comprehensive, Quran-only Muslims cannot follow the religion properly, e.g., mimic Muhammad, pray each day (five times: Sahih Bukhari [SB] 345), and in the right direction (Mecca: SB 4486), etc. Muslims need the Sira (biography by Muhammad ibn

Ishaq [AD707-753], edited by Ibn Hisham [d. ~AD840] but the original is lost), and Hadith (traditions).

## Muhammad

*Muhammad (pbuh) is one of the most documented religious figures in history. His existence and life are all carefully recorded and preserved*

False; the first purported written work about Muhammad is the *Sirat Rasul Allah*, ~**200 years after his death**. The most trusted accounts of his sayings were published by Muhammad Al-Bukhari **AD 846**. From 830-846, he collected 600,000 sayings before cutting them down to 7,563. He said Muhammad even appeared to him in a dream, interpreted as Bukhari, “clearing away false claims”<sup>9</sup>! Furthermore:

- “Muhammad” is only in the Qur’an four times;
- Unlike Jesus in the Bible, the Qur’an gives no birth or family details of Muhammad;
- An early witness of a prophet riding with Saracens is dated 634, 2 years *after* Muhammad’s death<sup>10</sup>;
- A figure on a Syrian ‘Muhammad’ coin dated 686 is adorned with *a cross*!

*The Ka’ba is the original place of worship which God commanded Abraham and Ishmael to build more than four*

*thousand years ago.*

There is no evidence Abraham ever went on an epic 1,400km journey from the wilderness of Beersheba with his son Ishmael to Mecca. “Mecca” isn’t even found in the written record till the 8<sup>th</sup>C!

The best proof though is in Q34.44, which says Allah never sent any books *or warners* to the Meccans before Muhammad, so Abraham could never have gone there.

*After several years in Medina the Prophet (pbuh) and his followers were able to return to Mecca triumphantly*

In March 628, after Muhammad had won the Battle of the Trench (627) against the Meccans, he made **a ten-year peace treaty** with them (Treaty of Hdaybiyya), which **he broke in 630** to attack Mecca!

*Before the Prophet (pbuh) died at the age of 63, the greater part of Arabia had accepted his message ... within a century of his death Islam spread to Spain in the West and as Far East as China.*

“Accepted” is an outrageous lie, proven by the fact that after Muhammad died in 632 (from poison by a Jewess: Sahih Muslim 5430; SB 4428), Arabian tribes *rejected* Islam under Caliph Abu Bakr, causing the Ridda

“Apostasy” Wars. The Muslims fought a one-year jihad to kill and subdue the apostates. After this in:

- 654: Muslims assassinated Caliph Uthman.
- 656: Caliph Ali fought Aisha in the First Fitna. At Battle of the Camel, Basra, 3,000 were killed.
- 680: Husayn (Muhammad’s grandson) was killed by Yazid I in the Second Fitna at the Battle of Karbala. This cemented the Shia/Sunni sect split.

From Arabia, Muslims attacked lands in the Middle East, Persia, Anatolia (Turkey), North Africa, Spain, France, and Italy, spreading Islam by war and terror.

### **Tax for the (support) of the Poor (ZAKAT)**

*In Arabic, Zakat means purification, growth and blessing. It is a charitable practice that requires all able Muslims (those who meet the requirement of Zakat) to contribute a fixed portion of their wealth – 2.5% of savings — to help the needy.*

AFIC omits that as a rule Zakat is to be given to *Muslims* only, *not* non-Muslims. It is conditional ‘charity’<sup>11</sup>.

### **Fasting (SAWM)**

*Muslims are required to observe the fast for one whole month every year during the Islamic lunar month of*

*Ramadan from first light until sundown, abstaining from food and drink ... The end of Ramadan is marked by a feast-day of Eid-al-Fitr.*

Ramadan ‘fasting’ ends up being the opposite: as it is only sunrise to sunset, Muslims can gorge themselves outside of this, not what people normally think of as fasting. Some Muslims actually *gain* weight (an estimated 17%<sup>12</sup>)!

### **Pilgrimage (HAJJ)**

*The annual pilgrimage to Mecca in Saudi Arabia ... The rites of the Hajj, which are of Abrahamic origin, include circling the Ka’ba seven times ... The close of the Hajj is marked by the Eid-al-Adha festival*

“Abrahamic origin” is a lie, since Abraham never went to Mecca (see above). Today, the Ka’ba is a few pieces of stone which Muslims kiss to forgive their sins, like Caliph Uthman and Muhammad did [SB 1597]!

Secondly, Eid-al-Adha celebrates the fiction Abraham offered *Ishmael*, the child of bondage. According to the Torah sent to Moses, in Genesis 22.1-19, it was *Isaac*, the child of promise.

### **Women in Islam**

*Men and women are equal in the sight of God ... Islam*

*gave rights to the woman at a time when there was no equality between men and women.*

Allah says the opposite in the Quran:

- Q2.282 equates the witness of two men with one man and *two* women!
- Muslim men can have up to four wives (Q4.3), plus unlimited captives, but Muslim women are limited to one husband and no male captives.

### **Extremism and terrorism condemned by Islam**

*Islam does not preach nor condones any form of terrorism or any acts of violence*

How AFIS can publish this is amazing. Q8.12: “...**I will instil terror into the hearts of the Unbelievers:** smite ye above their necks and smite all their finger-tips off them.”

And in SB 2977 Muhammad said:

“I have been sent with the shortest expressions bearing the widest meanings, and **I have been made victorious with terror.**”

Since 9/11/2001, [thereligionofpeace.com](http://thereligionofpeace.com) has documented **45,393** Islamic terrorist attacks! As comparison, there have been **0** terrorist attacks in the name of Christ.

### **Islam’s respect for other Religions**

*Islam teaches Muslims to be kind and just in dealing with people of other religions.*

Another lie to deceive the ignorant:

- Q8.42 commands global jihad till faith is all for Allah;
- Q98.6 calls Christians the worst of creatures because they reject Muhammad;
- Q9.29 states defeated Christians must be made to pay jizya until they feel humiliated.

How is the above “kind” in any plain meaning of the word?

### **Similarities between Islam, Christianity & Judaism**

*Christians and Jews are regarded as "People of the Book" because they follow one of ... the psalms of David, the Torah of Moses, the Injeel (Bible) of Jesus ... and the Qur'an ... These books contain the same fundamental message from God.*

False again:

- Not a single Jew or Christian in history has ever believed in Muhammad as a prophet. The moment one does he would cease to be a Jew or Christian;
- There is no such thing as a “Bible” of Jesus, rather, four gospel accounts of his life were written, plus 23 books making up the New Testament (NT);

- The Qur'an only contains the same message where it plagiarises, otherwise it is completely alien:
  - i. Unlike Jesus, Muhammad isn't prophesied in the Old Testament (OT). Nor is he found in the NT;
  - ii. The fundamental message of the OT is to trust in the living God, Jehovah, by faith, and await the coming Messiah, which is Jesus Christ;
  - iii. The fundamental message of the NT is to repent (i.e., change one's mind) and believe the gospel. The Qur'an has no gospel, it is another religion of works which can never assure salvation. In fact, the Qur'an (Q19.68-72) only assures every Muslim will enter hell (at least for a time)!
